# REST-assured

- **Problem** :- APIs are unstable and outside of our control which makes writing integration tests hard.
- REST-assured = HTTP test doubles.
- Mock response body & headers over real HTTP.
- Can manage transactions.
- Stable environment to write tests against.
- Lets us have different delivery schedules to other teams.

# Spassky

- **Problem** :- We need to make sure our JavaScript works on many different types of user agents.
- Spassky = Distributed JS unit test runner.
- Runs QUnit tests on any JS capable device.
- Parallel running of tests helps keep tests quick.
- Plugged in to Forge CI environment & reports back failures.

# Wally

- **Problem** :- Large amounts of BDD authored features make it really hard for everyone to grok the project
- Wally = Web-based viewer for Cucumber features
- Search, tag navigation, progress etc.
- Allows product owners/managers to communicate the **real** state of the project.

# Tsung

- **Problem** - Load testing on the platform is endlessly slow and not very revelatory.
- Tsung = Multi-protocol benchmarking (but we only use HTTP!)
- Run Tsung nightly so we can now see if previous days code changes have negatively effected performance.
- Want to cross reference with xhprof data and pull out and analyze slow requests.

# Git

- **Problem** :- We are asked (and want) to do code reviews but have not given any tools to do it.
- Exacerbated with a lots of teams working on a shared code base (as One News proposal dictates)
- Git has branch / pull request model so reviews are inherent in day to day activity.
- 9 out of 10 developers prefer it.
