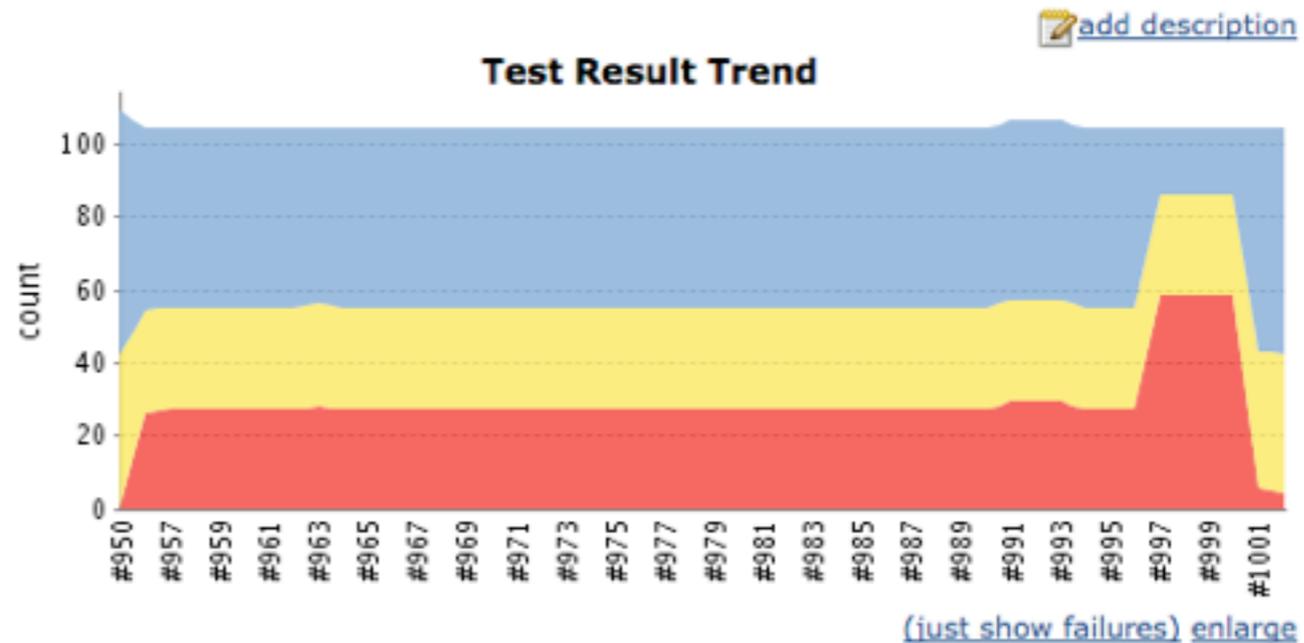

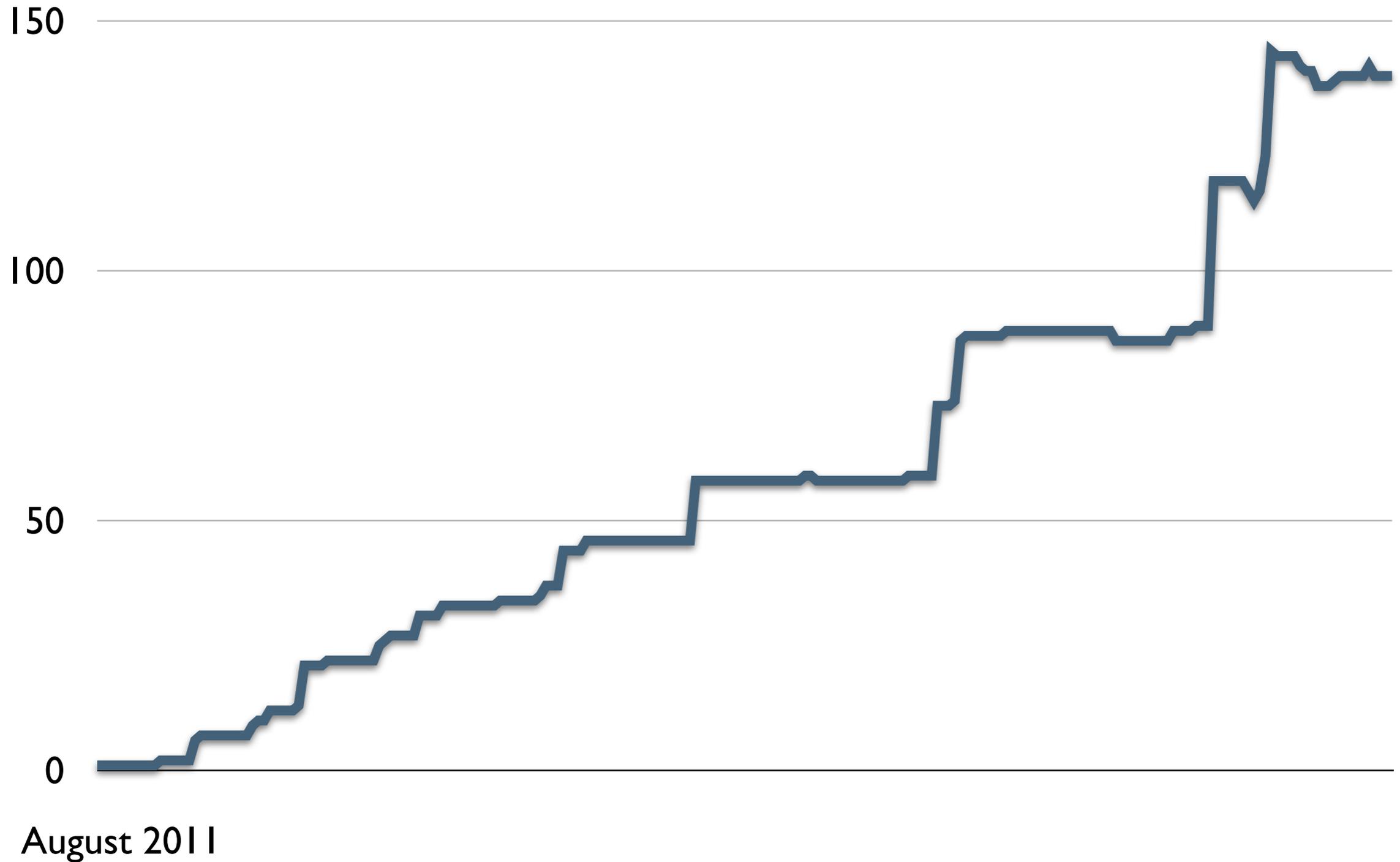

- Remembering your location history @NOTSTARTED

Remembering your location history I set my location to a valid UK place I set a new place I should see news & weather for the new location a button for the my previously set location(s) @notstarted

- Sharing location with News desktop @NOTSTARTED

Sharing location with News desktop I set my place to a valid UK place on the desktop site I visit the mobile frontpage I should see news & weather for that place @notstarted

- Weather override for local pages @NOTSTARTED

Weather override for local pages I set my location to Dorking I visit the Surrey region index I should see the weather for Dorking @notstarted
